### 3. Shopping

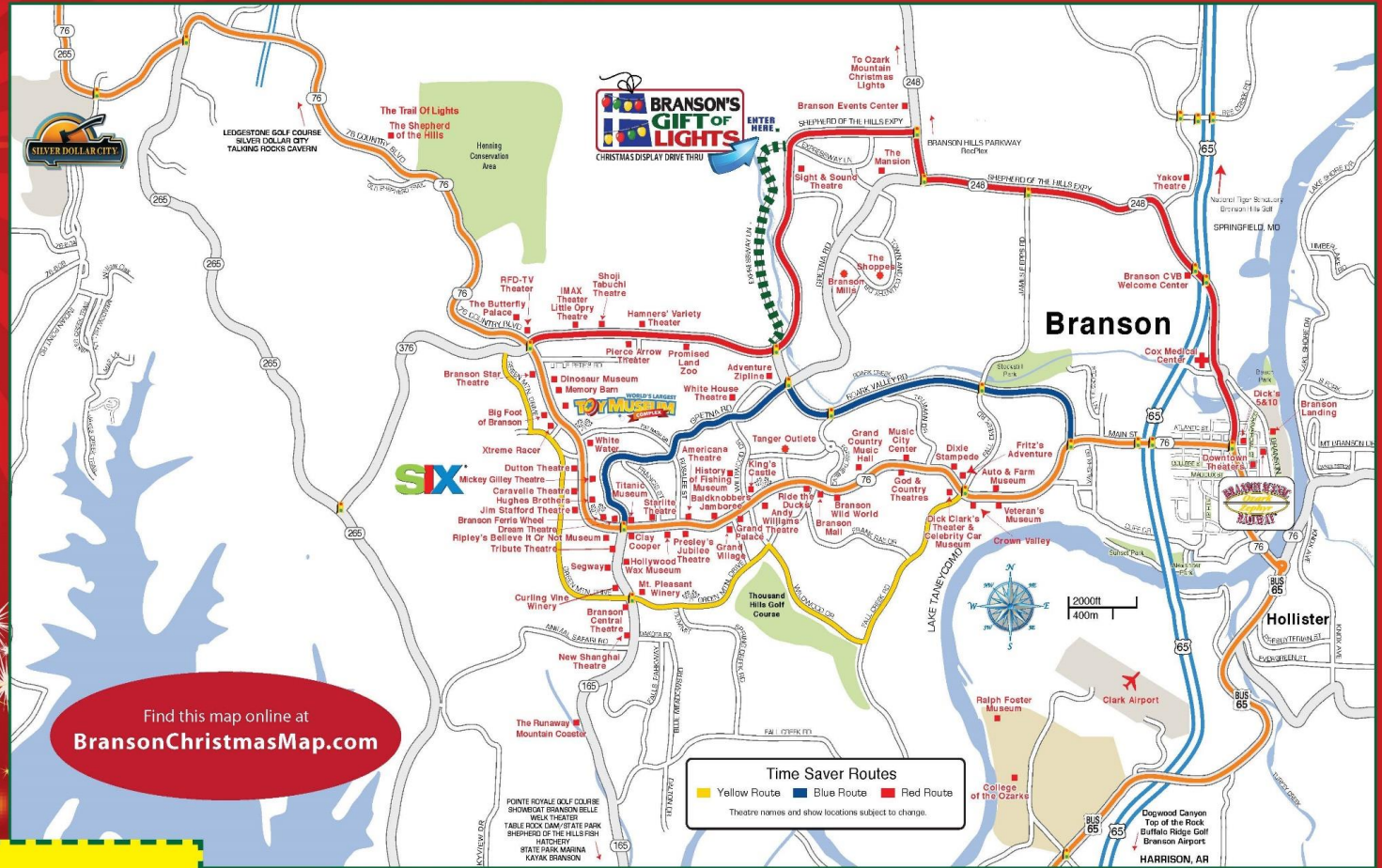
